

**The Joining Hands Network of Peru Inaugurates radio program in the city of La Oroya.**

With the purpose of carrying out, until October of this year, a public awareness campaign and with educating the population of La Oroya and the province of Yauli on the health situation of the area and, in addition, to demand compliance from the State on existing international agreements and recommendations for combating environmental pollution suffered by this same area, the Joining Hands Network of Peru launched a radio program called "Dialogue Weekly."

The radio program "Dialogue Weekly" aired on April 29th and is broadcast every Wednesday from 11 am to 12 noon on Radio La Oroya (OM 1460 and FM 100.1). The program is lead by a team of young journalists from our partners Filomena Tomaira Pacsi and Radio La Oroya. This team of producers and communicators is composed of Jaime Hurtado, Denis Chavez, Herlinda de La Torre, Edith Huamán and Carmen Pacheco. Coordinating the campaign is the CPDR El Día Del Pueblo along with partners from the Joining Hands Network Peru: Christian Life Fellowship, Peace and Hope.



The radio program "Dialogue Weekly" speaks to a number of themes including: "Talking about our environment," "The theme of the week", "Noti-news", and "Reclaiming our identity", among various others.



On Thursday May 14th of this year, a radio production workshop took place in La Oroya for the team's producers of "Dialogue Weekly" as well

as for youth groups from Yauli, Pucara and Morococha for the purpose of having correspondents in these areas.
